**8am ALL VEHICLES out of camp!  
Tow trucks arrive to begin removing vehicles.**

**8am**-Picket line registration and safety meeting Union representatives report to Capt. Belgie at Federal HQ. Confederate representatives report at Confederate HQ  
Breakfast in camps.

**9am** Camps & Attractions open to the public. Company Drill in camps.

**10am** Civilian Street opens till—**6pm**. On-going demonstrations of 19th century life.

**10am:** Cavalry demonstration on Drill field

**10:30am** Battalion Drill on Drill field at Sutler Area (Federal)

**11:30am** Artillery demonstration Union Camp

**12noon:** Cooper Shop Refreshment Saloon recreation with famed nurse: Anna M. Ross

**12noon:** Fifes and Drums Concert at the Sutlers' Crossroads

**1pm** Assembly. Military units form in camps for battle.

**1:30pm Battle**

**2:30pm** Spectator Battle at Landing area

**3pm** Battle ends. Hospital scenes

**3:30pm** Military parade to camps.

On-going activities in camps.

**6pm Camps closed to public**

Dinner in camps.

**6pm:** Grand Guard mount both camps pickets report to respective HQs for safety inspection and posting of orders

**8pm** Music by Camptown Shakers at Pavilion. Music provided by Regimental Quartermaster. Bring lanterns.

**12 midnight:** ‘Taps’ Lights out. All Quiet

## **Sunday**

**5am:** Picket line closes; any unit NOT on line at 4:59 will NOT be permitted to engage in the tactical

**6:30am** SUN RISE return to daylight rules of engagement; **6:30am** pickets only tactical

**7am** Reveille.

Breakfast. Police camps.

**8am** Church call in Union Camp

**9am** Camps & Attractions open to the public. Company Drill.

On-going camp vignettes.

**9:30am** Union Camp

Inspection by General Staff.

**10am** Tactical

**10am** Civilian Streets open to the public.

**11:00am** Morning Dress

Parade in camps. Weapons Inspection. Pass Inspection.

**11:30am** Brigade Review. (Federal)

On-going programs in sutler area.

**12 noon** Cavalry Review on Drill field.

Cooking demonstrations in camps.

**1pm** Artillery demonstration on battlefield area.

Assembly of troops in respective camps.

**1:30pm** Spectator Battle at Landing area by river.

**3pm** Battle concludes with honor ceremony.

**3:30** Hospital scenes in camps.

**4pm** Camps Close to Public Vehicles allowed in camps.

Police camps. Fill in fire pits.

Gather straw together.

Collect trash in bags.

Deposit trash at end of streets.

Leave the Park the way you found it.!
